- Sanford: 7 Delegates San Enterprise, San Discovery, San Granit, San Waitaki.
- Delegates hold an essential role communicating between the Guild and crew and can claim pay for Guild work.

## **Contract Levies**

- > Contract Levies is support funding for the Guild, following the removal of the Commercial Fisherman's levy and the Foreign Crew levy.
- > The Guild receives a payment of \$50 per head for each domestic, foreign and seasonal crew member, working on a NZ flagged vessel.
- ➤ 8 Fishing companies make this annual payment to the Guild Aurora DW NZ, Independent, Jaico, Maruha, Sanford, Sealord, Talley.



## **Nelson Fisherman's Centre**

- Guild have owned the NFC a long time, since the 1980's
- **❖ Guild had an office space in the NFC until 2016, when paid Delegates replaced the Guild rep**
- ❖ NFC has two tenants providing a dividend of around \$15,000 per year
- Due to increasing maintenance costs the decision has been made to sell the NFC
- Permission was provided by members at the 2016 AGM to sell the property
- We are currently going though the process of marketing the NFC

## **Guild Investments**

- ❖ Since 2016 the Guild has been running a solid net profit (Surplus)
- ❖ We now have \$450,000 in funds for investment & possibly a further \$270,000 from the sale of the NFC

## This helps provide

- \* A passive income for the Guild
- \* No increase in membership fees
- \* Legal costs funding, if needed
- The Guild Exec are discussing the best way to invest this money

# **Foreign Crew**



**NEW ZEALAND** 

- Fishing companies have an ongoing struggle to find good Kiwi crew on their deep-water vessels.
- **❖** Sealord are now employing foreign crew, particularly in factory roles and Sanford are interested in doing the same.
- Most factory trawlers are going to sea with at least 2 foreign crew.
  The factory on Sealord Tokatu is almost entirely foreign crew.
- Under the current situation, the Guild is accepting small numbers of foreign crew.
- We are working with Sealord who have agreed to pay Guild fees and to enable foreign crew to be Guild members.
- What we don't want is increasing numbers of foreigners taking jobs that should be rightfully Kiwi jobs.


